

COVID-19 Aide: Visitation Shelters



Our visitation shelters allow families to see loved ones in personal care homes whom they have been unable to visit. Each unit comes with a visiting room with a table and chairs and a sanitization room that is secured from the visiting room with a heavy-duty door.

Our visitation shelters are fully insulated, heated, air-conditioned, and come with the option of a built-in washroom. Everything from the interior walls to the chair seats can easily be wiped down and cleaned in order to remove any germs after each visit.

COVID-19 OUTBREAK IN MANITOBAN FIRST NATIONS *(as of October 14, 2020)*

- 60+ cases among 7 Manitoban First Nations communities
- Little Grand Rapids under a Code Red on the provincial pandemic response system after over 30 cases
- 43 active cases of COVID-19 among First Nations people in Manitoba (15% of all active cases in the province)

HOW COBRA ENTERPRISES IS HELPING

- Each visitation shelter can remain attached to a personal care home through a fabric building corridor provided by Cobra Structures.
- Bison Container Homes and Cobra Structures are pooling their resources to assemble Rapid Deployment Shelters wherever needed.
